Founded in Ay in 1584 Champagne Gosset is the oldest wine house in Champagne. Continued excellence is ensured by Odilon de Varine, Gosset Cellar Master. 2004 was a perfect year for creating a vintage with ageing capacity. It is well balanced with a beautiful finesse and assertive structure.

Tasting note

This Cuvée is pale golden with green tints typical of Chardonnay. Its fine and abundant bubbles finish in a light and steady ribbon. Motes of white flowers, lemon, wild mushrooms. This is a champagne with finesse, complexity and precision, generous and well balanced.
