Aloxe-Corton is the native village of the Latour family. The name "Les Chaillots" refers to the stony, pebbly nature of the soil in the vineyard, as "caillou" means pebble in French. The Les Chaillots vineyard is part of Domaine Louis Latour.

This wine is of a shimmering ruby red colour. It has an intense nose with aromas of cherry and liquorice, accompanied by woody hints. It is round in the mouth and tannins are present. This wine has notes of liquorice and sap on the finish.
