#### Wine description

Lancié has always been given to produce some of the finest wines of the Beaujolais-Villages zone. Maison Louis Latour only selects high quality, traditionally vinified wines which possess intensely scented bouquets coupled with rich flavours and persistent fruity aftertaste. The vineyards of Beaujolais Villages Lancié are bordered on three sides by renowned Crus, Moulin-à-Vent in the north, Fleurie to the east and Morgon as its immediate southern neighbour. Lancié sits on the same granite layers and benefits from the same exposure and easterly orientation as the Cru vineyards surrounding it.

#### Tasting note

This wine of garnet colour is intense. On the nose, aromas of violet and strawberry are showing. Ample and rich in the mouth with sweet notes of strawberry and raspberry. It has a great freshness on the finish.
