Wine description

Beaune is the wine capital of the region and has played a significant role in the history of Burgundy. Les Vignes Franches is one of the best Premier Cru vineyards of the town, producing a wine that is persuasively elegant and graceful with a fragrant floral nose and yet well capable of ageing to perfection for a considerable period of time. This wine comes from Louis Latour's own domaine.

Tasting note

With its lovely ruby red colour, the Beaune Vignes Franches 2010 displays the classic aromas of the noble Pinot Noir: cherry, liquorice and some slightly spiced notes. The tannins are smooth and adds structure to the wine, giving it a wonderful elegance, the overall is well balanced.
