Bourgogne Pinot Noir is the everyday drinking wine from the Burgundy region with its grapes originating from vineyards all over the Burgundy region. The wines tend to be simpler in style, offering fresh fruity flavours which are best drunk in their youth or within a few years of release.

Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2015 is bright ruby in colour with aromas of raspberry and red cherry. The palate continues with red fruits but also with a hint of herbeaceous, gamey flavours.
