Wine description

The Pinot Noir grapes for this wine are sourced in Santenay, Auxey-Duresses and a range of other well placed yet lesser known vineyards of the Côte de Beaune. The resulting wine gives a snap shot of the Côte de Beaune; tending to be quite a rich style with broad red berry and liquorice flavours.

Tasting note

A vibrant, medium intensity wine with light tannin and freshness. Fruit characters are in the fruits of the forest spectrum. The wine has a nice light texture on the mid palate and a fruity finish.
