Wine description

Chablis is an island of vineyards in the north of Burgundy halfway between Dijon and Paris. Maison Louis Latour's Chablis is a classic example of Chardonnay from this region which is strongly influenced by the region's famous kimmeridgian limestone slopes which bring a flinty minerality to the wines.

Tasting note

The 2012 Chablis is a luminous light yellow in colour with pretty flecks of green. On the nose, floral notes are deepened with alluring citrus aromas. Round, this wine delivers a lovely freshness with lemon and herbal notes.
