Wine description

The Côte de Beaune-Villages appellation is applied exclusively to red wines from 16 communes in the Côte de Beaune including Saint-Aubin, Pernand-Vergelesses and Auxey-Duresses. Maison Louis Latour carefully selects the wines which are the most representative of the appellation.

Tasting note

The 2014 is ruby red in colour with garnet-red hues. On the nose, it reveals aromas of redcurrents, blackcurrant and strawberry. The mouth is ample with flavours of red fruits and savoury notes on the finish.
