Wine description

The Montagny appellation includes vineyards in the Côte Chalonnaise villages of Montagny, Buxy, Saint Vallerin and Jully-les-Buxy. The appellation is only for Chardonnay wines and includes village and premier cru designated sites. Montagny Premier Cru La Grande Roche benefits from its location quite high on a sunny hillside on a limestone bedrock.

Tasting note

Sparkling pale yellow in colour, 2010 Montagny 1er Cru La Grande Roche has a floral nose paired with notes of exotic fruits and almonds. The palate is rich and round, there is nice freshness on the back-palate and good length on the finish.
