Wine description

The Montagny appellation includes vineyards in the Côte Chalonnaise villages of Montagny, Buxy, Saint Vallerin and Jully-les-Buxy. The appellation is only for Chardonnay wines and includes village and premier cru designated sites. Montagny Premier Cru La Grande Roche benefits from its location quite high on a sunny hillside on a limestone bedrock.

Tasting note

Of a lovely light golden colour the Montagny 1er Cru "La Grande Roche" reveals aromas of muscat and fresh almonds accompanied by a hint of pepper. In the mouth, it is ample with vanilla and muscat notes. It has a lovely minerality on the finish.
