Wine description

The Montagny appellation includes vineyards in the Côte Chalonaise villages of Montagny, Buxy, Saint Vallerin and Jully-les-Buxy. The appellation is only for Chardonnay wines and includes village and premier cru designated sites. Montagny Premier Cru La Grande Roche benefits from its location quite high on a sunny hillside on a limestone bedrock.

Tasting note

This wine has a bright, light golden color. On the nose complex notes of peach and a hint of muscat. The mouth is ample with floral aromas and iodine and peppery notes. The finish has a lovely freshness.
