Grapes, must and finished wines are all bought and taken to Louis Latour's Clos Chameroy winery, located on the outskirts of Beaune, where they are blended and aged to produce a high quality, classic white Burgundy wine.

# **Tasting note**

Sparkling pale yellow in colour with pretty floral and white peach aromas. The palate is dry, light-medium body and balanced acidity. It is rounded in the mouth with pear and peach fruit and a fresh slightly grassy finish.
