Wine description

Puligny-Montrachet geographical middleman of the Côte de Beaune's 3 great white wine villages, bordered by Meursault to the north and by Chassagne-Montrachet to the south with which it harbours 5 of the 6 white Grands Crus in Burgundy. Puligny- Montrachet Les Truffières is situated high up on the slope just below the hamlet of Blagny. As the name suggests this vineyard was once a truffle-bed and now the wines it produces are equally sought after.

Tasting note

This wine is rich and powerful without letting go of its remarkable finesse. Packed with ripe exotic fruits and a buttery fatness, the acidity balances the wine and keeps it steely.
