## Savigny-lès-Beaune blanc

#### Wine description

Savigny-lès-Beaune blanc is an extremely rare wine counting for no more than 3.5% of the total production of the village. The best slopes for Savigny-lès-Beaune blanc are to be found 10 minutes drive north of Beaune at the western end of the appellation going towards the tiny village of Boulliand. It is on these upper vineyard sites that the Chardonnay thrives. Some growers compare these higher vineyards and their soil content to those of the famed Corton-Charlemagne.

#### Tasting note

Of a light golden colour, this Savigny-lès-Beaune blanc has a fruity nose with aromas of white plums. In the mouth, it has a lovely roundness with hints of lemon and almonds. It has a lovely mineral finish.
