#### Wine description

The grapes are from the clay and ironstone pebbly soils prevalent on the McHenry Hohnen Vineyards south of Margaret River. With a northerly aspect, the vines enjoy long days of sunshine, moderated by the vineyard's southern location. Vineyard management embraces sustainable 'old school' practices following biodynamic principles.

#### **Tasting note**

An earthy and intense blend, made via traditional method vinification, reveals a complex and alluring wine that is an authentic representation of variety, site and season. Made with minimal additives, this bold natural wine is unfined and unfiltered. Each variety contributes to a complete yet enigmatic blend, far exceeding the sum of the individual parts.
