Wine description

McHenry Hohnen's 2017 Semillon Sauvignon Blanc is a blend made entirely from the family's own vineyards. The Sauvignon Blanc (45%) comes from the Burnside Vineyard which is one of the older sites for Sauvignon Blanc in Margaret River planted in 1983.

Tasting note

A lifted and vibrant blend with exotic tropical and passion fruit aromas and nuances of fresh sugar snap peas. A lively palate of lychees and fresh pineapple gives way to delicate citrus blossom and mineral layers. Some texture and sweetness from a small portion fermented in barrel tempered by crisp citrus acidity makes for a bright and lingering finish.
