Wine description

Established in 1781 in the Northern Rhone Valley, Vidal-Fleury is the oldest continuously operating winery in the Rhone Valley. The wine is made of Syrah (95%) & Viognier (5%) both from terraces mainly on the Côte Brune and the Côte Blonde.

Tasting note

This wine is dark red in colour. It is showing fresh fruits, violet, pepper, smoky and black olive aromas. The palate is rich and full bodied with good balance. Ample red fruit, blackcurrant, spice flavours with a persistent finish.
