Wine description

St Joseph was created as an appellation in 1956 and while mainly red, there are pockets of white wines made from Marsanne and Roussanne.

Tasting note

A full-bodied, aromatic wine driven by white stone fruit flavours combined with creamy brioche. Good levels of acidity running through the palate into the finish.
