## Wine description

The Gran Reserva wines are made using grapes from specially selected sites within Viu Manent's estate and are defined by their greater complexity, elegance and balance. The Cabernet Sauvignon is from old vines on the San Carlos Vineyard located close to town of Cunaco. 5% Cabernet Franc were added.

## **Tasting note**

Deep and intense ruby red. The complex and intense nose recalls fresh red fruits such as sour cherries, blackcurrants, and black cherries. The palate is smooth, lush, fresh, and vibrant with a pleasing, delicate finish.
