The grapes for this wine come from a selection of the best sectors of blocks 1, 2, 3, and 4 from La Capilla Vineyard near the town of Peralillo in the Colchagua Valley. These blocks of Cabernet Sauvignon average of 22 years in age.

Intense cherry red with complex aromas of red fruits, blackcurrants and cherries with herbal notes, fresh leather, cedar and cigar box. Refreshing palate features great structure with rich texture, subtle mineral notes and great depth on the finish.
