Wine description

The Reserva Chardonnay (96% Chardonnay and 4% Viognier) was grown on both Viu Manent's San Carlos vineyard near Cunaco and a vineyard in the foothills of the Andes Mountains in the Colchagua Valley.

Tasting note

Clean, bright and greenish-yellow in colour. This wine expresses fresh fruity aromas that recall citrus fruits, melon and just-picked apples along with floral notes accompanied by a mineral edge. The palate shows good volume and is fresh, well balanced, and fruity with a long, harmonious, and lightly mineral finish.
