Wine description

The Single Vineyard selection showcases special sites with strong individual character within Viu Manent's estate. This Malbec is made from 80 year old vines from blocks 4 and 5 of the San Carlos vineyard located near the town of Cunaco in the Colchagua Valley. Rain in the winter, warm dry summer days and cool nights coupled with sea and mountain breezes create the perfect micro climate for grape production.

Tasting note

This limited edition wine presents a deep, intense purple-onyx color, along with an intense and elegant nose marked by aromas of ripe fruits such as blackberries, blueberries, and plums, as well as spices, subtle floral notes, and blonde tobacco. The fruity palate has tremendous structure and tannins that make their presence known while maintaining their velvety texture—all leading to a deep and persistent finish.
