Champagne Gosset

Gosset, Champagne's oldest wine house, holds a special place in the history of the region.

Still family owned and fiercely independent, the house remains quality orientated and focused on low volumes. This has allowed them to maintain a very selective grape sourcing policy and their unique wine style. The grapes are sourced primarily from premier and grand cru sites surrounding the villages of Aÿ and Epernay, from growers with whom Gosset have long standing relationships. The winemaking that follows aims to maintain vibrancy and freshness but the wines are not rushed and are allowed extended time in the company's cellars. The resulting wines reveal the characters imparted by the soil, cool climate and the hands of the people who create them. These are beautifully pure champagnes and a dedication to a slow and unhurried production process.

Domaine Michel Redde et Fils

The Redde family's domaine is a patchwork of the different terroirs within the Pouilly-Fumé appellation. It extends over 42 hectares and is called La Moynerie thanks to the monastery that once stood on the site.

The family's wines capitalise on the variety of terroirs and emphasise their diversity and differing characteristics through a range of single vineyard wines.

Since 2020 the estate has been farmed organically and from the 2023 vintage, will be officially certified Organic by Ecocert. To comply with Biodynamic methodologies, the Redde family prepare their own herbal preparations to reinforce the immune system of the vines.

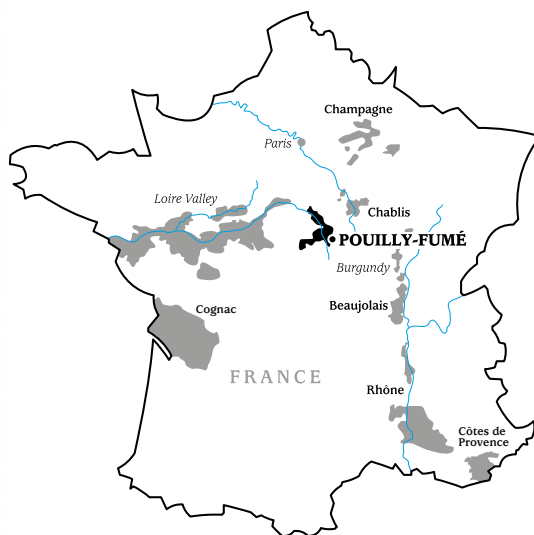

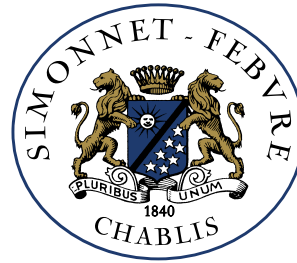

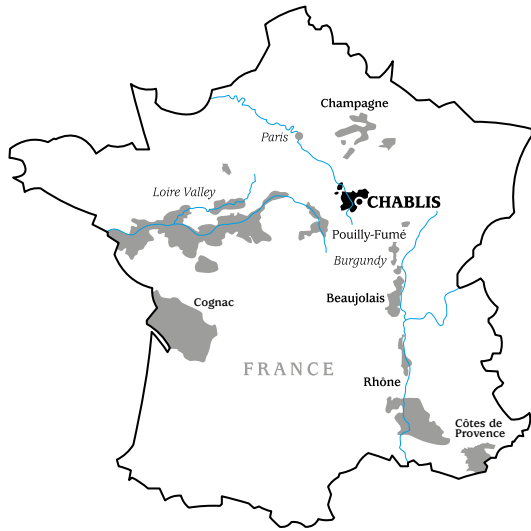
Simonnet-Febvre was founded in 1840, initially producing sparkling wines, before joining its peers in still wine production around Chablis. Today, they maintain their founding traditions, excelling in still and sparkling styles, but uniquely being the only Chablis producer to produce sparkling wines. A third of total wine production is still devoted to sparkling styles.

The Crémant de Bourgogne wines are made from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes grown on cooler hillside locations around Chablis. The wines are made in the company's historic Chablis cellar where they spend a minimum of 24 months on lees and undergo riddling in old hand-operated mechanical gyropallete and manual disgorgement.

Simonnet-Febvre

Simonnet-Febvre was founded in 1840 by Jean Febvre a barrel maker from Montbard.

Recognising its potential, Louis Latour purchased Simonnet-Febvre in 2003. They embarked on a lengthy programme of investment in expertise, infrastructure and vineyards that continues to this day. As a result the house's wines and reputation have been transformed. Today's range of still wines includes classic Chablis alongside lesser known appellations such as Irancy and Saint-Bris. New vineyards in the rediscovered Auxois region to the south of Chablis have brought interest with wines from Auxerrois, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

Domaine Louis Latour

The domaine vineyards are a central part of Maison Louis Latour. The Latour's connection to Aloxe-Corton dates back to 1731 when the family bought vineyards in the village.

Over the years Louis Latour's vineyard holdings have grown to encompass almost 50 hectares in the Côte d'Or alone. This includes 27 hectares of Grand Cru, making Louis Latour the largest owner of Grand Cru vineyards in Burgundy. Alongside this there are Les Pierres Dorées vineyards near Lyon and further vineyards to the south in the Ardèche and the Var.

Sustainability and Maison Louis Latour

Maison Louis Latour has actively practiced sustainable viticulture since the early 1990s and worked hard to preserve and understand the ecosystem of which they are a part.

Christophe Deola, Louis Latour's Domaine Director, shares his predecessors' vision and continues to embrace traditional viticultural methods where the care of the soil is essential to allow the vines to thrive. Examples of this commitment include non-chemical pest control, the production of their compost and active engagement in research. Louis Latour have held ISO 14001 Environmental Management Systems certification since 2003 and are 'High Environmental Value Level 3' (HVE3) certified in the use of biodiversity, phytosanitary strategy, water usage and fertilisers. They were a founding member of the Paysage de Corton association in 2011.

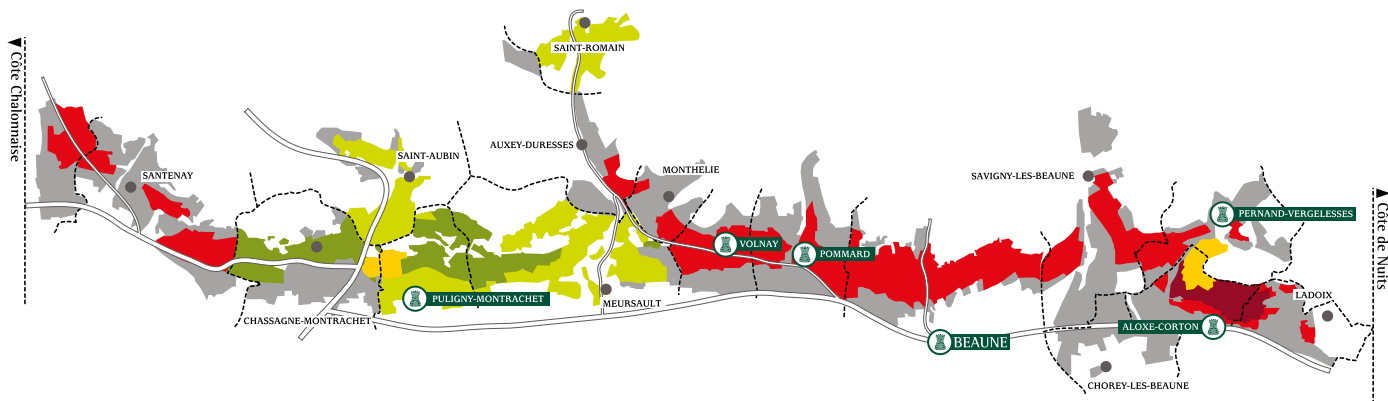

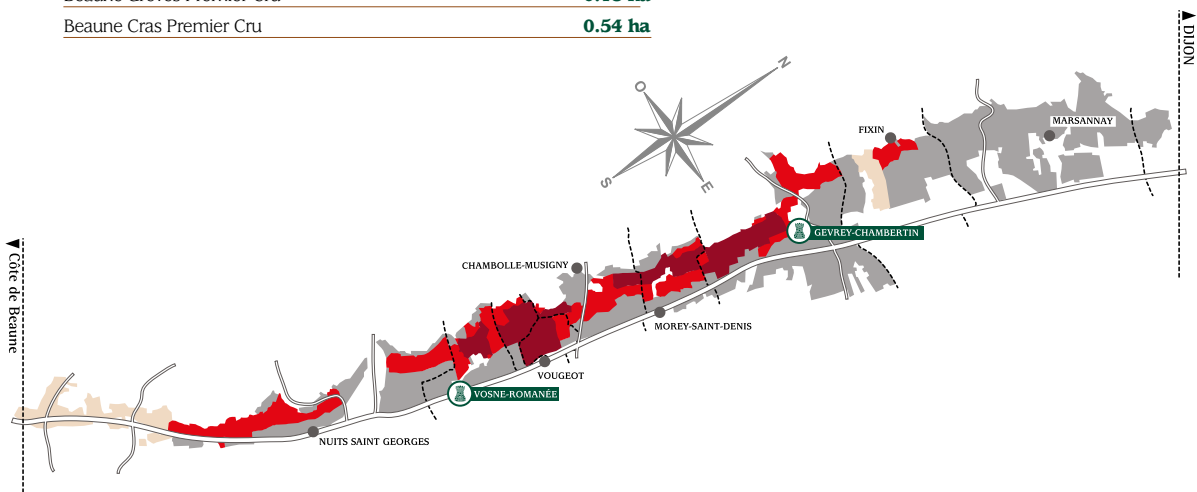

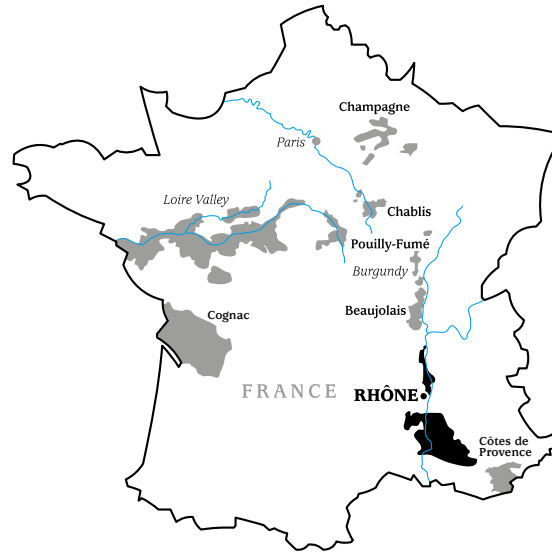

Vidal-Fleury

Vidal-Fleury can trace its roots back to 1781 when it was founded in the tiny village of Ampuis.

For their first 140 years Vidal-Fleury focused on the Northern Rhône however, in the 1920s they looked to the south and extended their range. By the mid-twentieth century they had become one of the Rhône's most iconic names. In the last decade Vidal-Fleury have seen a further renewal of fortunes beginning with the opening of their new cellar in 2008, and since 2020, with winemaker Antoine Dupré. Today Vidal-Fleury's collection of 20 appellations, including the flagship Côte-Rôtie La Chatillonne, offer an exceptional insight into Rhône Valley wines.

Château Sainte Roseline

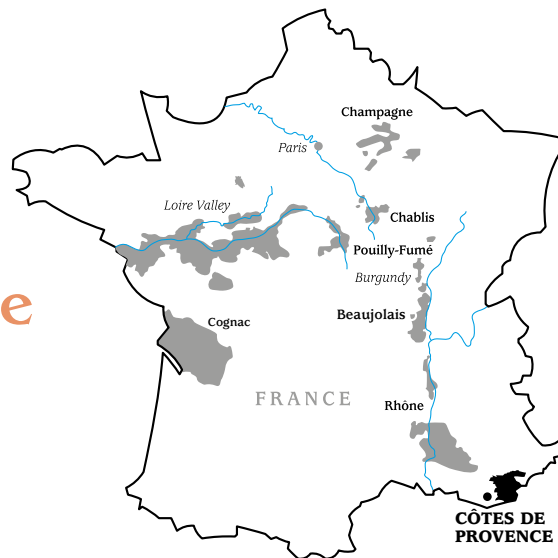
Located in Les Arcs-sur-Argens between the Gorges du Verdon and Saint Tropez in the Côtes de Provence appellation, Château Sainte Roseline is an historic estate whose origins date back to the 12th century. It is one of the 18 remaining Cru Classé estates in Provence and the only one in Les Arcs.

Today the estate is owned and managed by Aurélie Bertin who produces red, white and rosé wines from her 110 hectares of vineyards that benefit from clay limestone soils and a close proximity to the Mediterranean.

The team at Château Sainte Roseline are committed to socially equitable and environmentally sound working practices. It received High Environmental Value Level 3 certification in 2019 and has held organic certification since the 2022 vintage.

Château des Demoiselles

Château des Demoiselles is a single estate in the Esclans Valley in the heart of Provence. The estate was initially owned by the Bertin Teillaud family from 1956 until 1978. In 2005 they were able to re-acquire it and changed the name to Château des Demoiselles. This was in honour of the current director, Aurélie Bertin Teillaud, who has instilled a new mood and dynamism to it and their sister property Château Sainte Roseline.

The property includes a total of 300 hectares and of these 72 are planted with vines, growing grapes such as Rolle, Syrah, Grenache and Cinsault to produce the estate's red, white and rosé wines.

The estate sits within a Natura 2000 reserve which was established for the protection of habitats, species and biodiversity. Château des Demoiselles was awarded High Environmental Value Level 3 certification in 2019 and has held organic certification since the 2022 vintage.

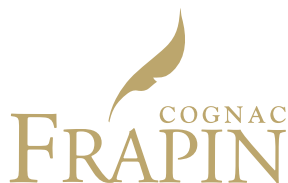

Cognac Frapin

Frapin is an artisanal cognac house, still in original family ownership, that has operated from the same location since 1270. In their 750 plus years of history they have amassed one of the region's finest Grande Champagne estates and an unparalleled knowledge passed through more than 21 generations.

Today all Frapin's cognacs are made on its 340 hectare estate: from the vineyard and winemaking, to distillation, ageing and blending. This, combined with their unhurried, handcrafted approach, has resulted in a range of award winning cognacs, recognised throughout the world for their quality and complexity.

Since 1991 Frapin has been working to minimise its environmental impact which culminated in High Environmental Value level 3 (HVE 3) certification in 2018. HVE 3 is a major French accreditation which focuses on biodiversity conservation, protection of flora and fauna, water resource management and limiting the use of artificial pesticides in favour of natural alternatives.

To mark this milestone, Frapin redesigned Cigar Blend XO's packaging. Cardboard and ink usage were reduced, and uncoated paper stock used resulting in a box that is completely recyclable with a 25% carbon footprint reduction. 100% carbon neutrality was achieved through participation in a Climate Partner climate protection project which, to date, has planted more than 1 million trees across 32 French forests.

Cobalte is a unique vodka from Aÿ-Champagne made with Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Meunier grapes from the Montagne de Reims. It is a terroir vodka that fuses minerality, roundness of fruit and freshness, bringing balance and a silky-smooth finish.

Cobalte is exclusively made from healthy and ripe hand-picked grapes which are vinified, and then distilled multiple times with its lees. This unhurried process helps to infuse Cobalte with its personality and identity, producing a French vodka of extraordinary purity and finesse.

The name Cobalte comes from two sources of inspiration. The first is Reims' historic connection to the French monarchy which is strongly associated with the colour cobalt blue. With a few exceptions, most French monarchs were crowned at Reims Cathedral. The second comes from cobalt the mineral and is a nod to the mineral notes found in Cobalte's flavour profile.

Castello Banfi

Banfi was created in 1978 by the Mariani family who saw potential in the vineyards located just south of Montalcino.

In the 1970s there were few vineyards around Montalcino and the area's wines did not enjoy today's reputation. However, the Marianis were determined and committed to extensive research projects working with several Italian universities. Today the Banfi estate covers around 3000 hectares of which one third are planted to vine across a myriad of single vineyard sites. Banfi's vineyards include Brunello and Moscadello plantings alongside incoming varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Pinot Grigio.

Banfi in Tuscany

Banfi Toscana is the name given to the Tuscan wines Banfi makes outside Montalcino. The Mariani family have developed vineyards in Chianti, Bolgheri and Maremma where a selection of local and international varieties are planted including the delicious Vermentino from coastal Maremma which is a component of La Pettegola.



Banfi in Piedmont

Banfi's Piedmont project began in 1979 with the purchase of a winery in Bruzzone and 50 hectares of vineyards between Novi Ligure and Acqui Terme. Here production is focused on sparkling wines, Gavi and Albarossa, a crossing of Nebbiolo di Dronero and Barbera created in the 1930s.

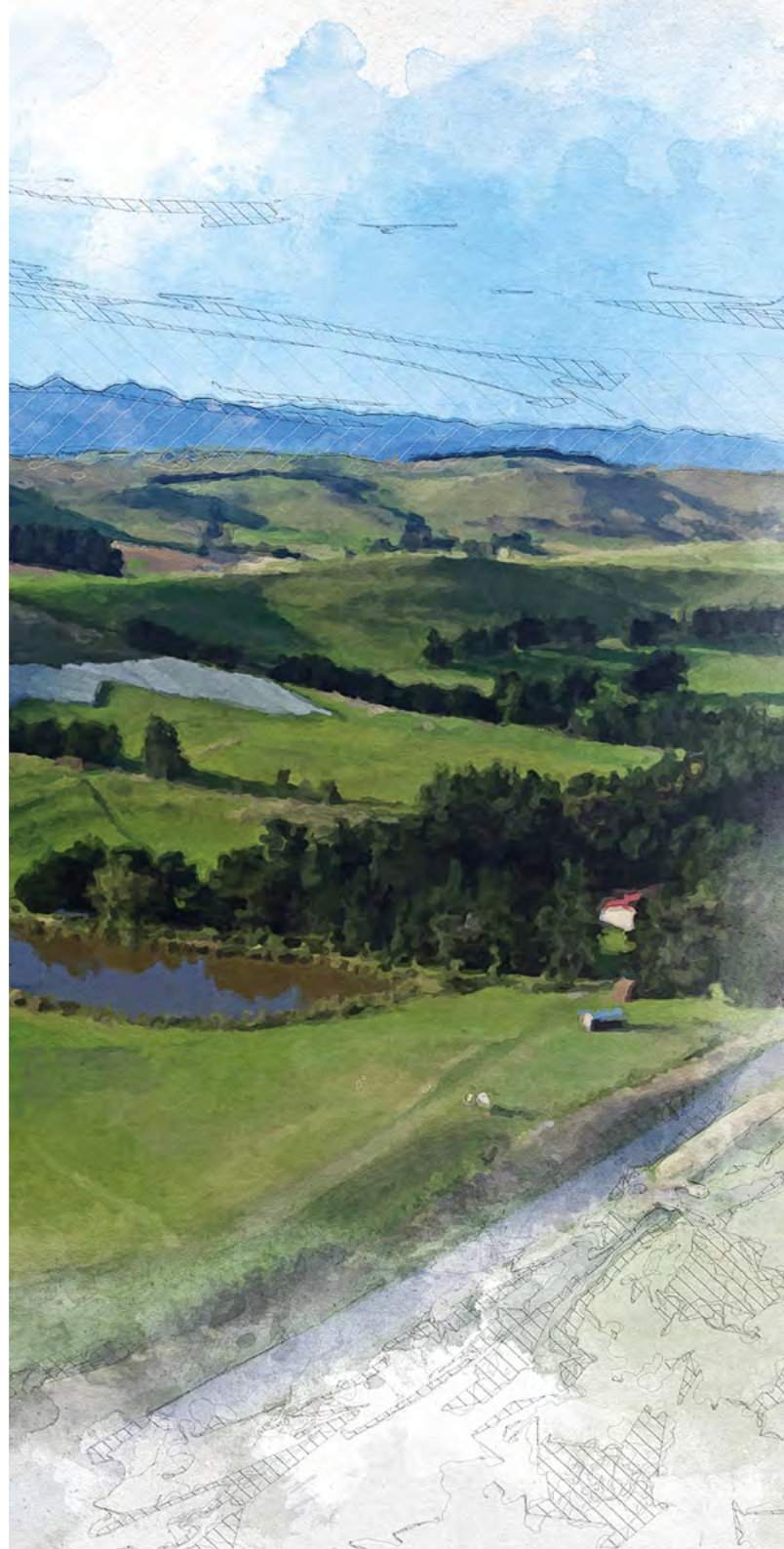
Pyramid Valley

Pyramid Valley is one of the pre-eminent practitioners of biodynamic viticulture in New Zealand.

Pyramid Valley, founded in 2000, was carefully chosen after searching the world for the best place to grow Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, finally settling on a unique site in North Canterbury near the town of Waikari. In 2017, a second vineyard was purchased in Lowburn, Central Otago. Now owned by Steve Smith MW and Brian Sheth, both sites are managed by Huw Kinch, estate manager and winemaker, following biodynamic principles in viticulture and winemaking, adhering to natural processes, with the use of indigenous yeast, no additives, natural fining and little, if any, filtration.

Viu Manent's history dates back to 1935 when Catalan immigrants Miguel Viu Garcia and his sons Augustin and Miguel Viu Manent founded a company in Santiago de Chile to buy and bottle wines under the Viu label.

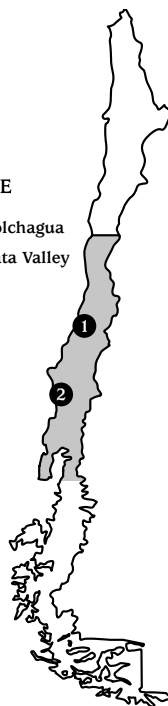
In 1966 the family fulfilled a long-held ambition and bought the vineyards from where they sourced wines, the Hacienda San Carlos in the Colchagua Valley. The vineyards had been established in the 19th Century with plants imported from France before Phylloxera and contained old Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon vines.

Today Viu Manent have two additional vineyards, El Olivar and La Capilla, both located west of San Carlos on slopes in the Peralillo area. The development of the family's vineyards has been thanks to research and a desire to exploit different zones along the full length of the Colchagua Valley. Since 2014 they have also worked in Colchagua's cooler, coastal vineyards in Litueche.
