Wine description

The estate's vineyards are located in Les Arcs-sur-Argens, one of Provence's most sought after terroirs, and was awarded the "Cru Classé" distinction in 1955. The vines, planted on clay and limestone soils, are nourished with water from a deep natural spring, producing quality Rosé, White and Red wines.

Tasting note

A serious nose of bramble and blackcurrant that dominates beyond the nose. Hints of red fruits, violets and liquorice all play their part in this powerful and luscious example. The bramble and blackcurrant are seriously concentrated on the palate, with touches of black pepper and chocolate, evoking a joyful finish to its long length.
