Wine description

Aloxe-Corton is the native village of the Latour family. The name "Les Chaillots" refers to the stony, pebbly nature of the soil in the vineyard, as "caillou" means pebble in French. The Les Chaillots vineyard is part of Domaine Louis Latour.

Tasting note

On the nose, this wine is of a distinctive character with a bouquet said to resemble freshly baked bread. It is very pleasant with typical Pinot Noir nuances, dominated by mixed berries, underbrush and ferns. With great broadness on the palate, Aloxe Corton 1er cru Les Chaillots reveals power, coupled with solid persistence on the finish.
