Aloxe-Corton is the native village of the Latour family. The name "Les Chaillots" refers to the stony, pebbly nature of the soil in the vineyard, as "caillou" means pebble in French. The Les Chaillots vineyard is part of Domaine Louis Latour.

This Chaillots is a beautiful ruby red colour and has a heady perfume of cherries and liquorice. A wine of great elegance with mellow tannins and beautiful length.
