Wine description

Aloxe-Corton is the native village of the Latour family. The name "Les Chaillots" refers to the stony, pebbly nature of the soil in the vineyard, as "caillou" means pebble in French. Les Chaillots vineyard is part of Domaine Louis Latour.

Tasting note

This wine is bright with a deep garnet-red colour. An intense nose of black cherry and undergrowth. On the palate spices mix with black cherry and blackcurrant fruit, liquorice and nutmeg.
