Wine description

Produced from hand-picked grapes grown on clay limestone soils and then carefully vinified in Latour's Ardèche winery on the outskirts of the village of Alba La Romaine. Thirty percent of the wine is aged in French oak barrels from Latour's cooperage giving roundness and a slightly spicy edge. The remaining seventy percent is vinified entirely in stainless steel.

Tasting note

This wine has a very nice pale golden colour. The nose is fresh, of juicy apricot and almond. The mouth is ample and generous, almost syrupy, with hints of apricot nectar.
