Wine description

From the gently sloping hillside overlooking the ancient walled town of Beaune comes this classic white Burgundy. White Beaune accounts for only 5% of the total production from this appellation. The soil in this region is made up of chalk and limestone which suits Chardonnay well. The unique terroir and traditional oak cask ageing produce a wine with an elegant bouquet, which is rich and thick in body.

Tasting note

This wine has a pale yellow colour, with a floral nose and fresh hazelnuts overtones. This ample wine displays honeysuckle, vanilla aromas and a nice mineral finish.
