Bourgogne Pinot Noir is the everyday drinking wine from the Burgundy region with its grapes originating from vineyards all over the Burgundy region. The wines tend to be simpler in style offering fresh fruity flavours which are best drunk in their youth within a few years of release.

Appealing ripe cherry and berry fruit aromas are followed by intensely fruity summer berry flavours, balanced acidity and supple tannins on the palate.
