Bourgogne Pinot Noir is the everyday drinking wine from the Burgundy region with its grapes originating from vineyards all over the Burgundy region. The wines tend to be simpler in style offering fresh fruity flavours which are best drunk in their youth within a few years of release.

This wine has a bright ruby color. The nose reveals notes of cassis, liquorice and raspberries. The mouth is round with cherry aromas and mellow tannins.
