Bourgogne Pinot Noir is the everyday drinking wine from the Burgundy region with its grapes originating from vineyards all over the Burgundy region. The wines tend to be simpler in style, offering fresh fruity flavours which are best drunk in their youth or within a few years of release.

The nose reveals aromas of blackcurrant with a hint of savoury undergrowth. The palate is round with vibrant fruity notes and a soft finish.
