Wine description

The Grand Cru vineyard of Bâtard-Montrachet lies between the picturesque villages of Puligny-Montrachet and Chassagne-Montrachet, home to the world's greatest white wines. Only a small country lane separates this 12.37 hectare vineyard from the great Montrachet itself. Its gentle easterly-facing slope is made up of deep, rich, gravelly soil which has a limestone base, world renowned for the production of high quality Chardonnay fruit.

Tasting note

Sparkling gold in the glass this wine offers an exquisite bouquet of honey, hazelnut and vanilla. It reveals balanced acidity and a full, plump structure in the mouth. Nuts and spice come together to reveal a luxurious and opulent wine.
