Wine description

Chassagne-Montrachet and its neighbour Puligny-Montrachet are well-known for their Grand Crus, the most famous being the Montrachet. However, apart from these white Grand Crus, Chassagne-Montrachet also produces, on its clay and iron-rich soils, excellent red wines with heady aromas of cherry and blueberry.

Tasting note

This wine has complex aromas that give an aromatic and spicy nose: liquorice, vanilla, undergrowth and black fruits. The mouth is round and fresh and the tannins are supple with blackcurrant and cherry notes.
