## Wine description

The Côte de Beaune-Villages appellation is applied exclusively to red wines from 16 communes in the Côte de Beaune including Saint-Aubin, Pernand-Vergelesses and Auxey-Duresses. Maison Louis Latour carefully selects the wines which are the most representative of the appellation: lots of character, intense aromatics, and of course, a long finish.

### Tasting note

Light brick red in colour with pronounced cherry aromas. The palate iis fresh and balanced, with abundant red fruits and hints of menthol. Good length on the palate, a significant aromatic presence and balanced tannins. A very charming wine.
