Wine description

The Côte de Beaune-Villages appellation is applied exclusively to red wines from 16 communes in the Côte de Beaune including Saint-Aubin, Pernand-Vergelesses and Auxey-Duresses. Maison Louis Latour carefully selects the wines which are the most representative of the appellation: lots of character, intense aromatics, and of course, a long finish.

Tasting note

Light brick red in colour with pronounced cherry aromas. The palate is fresh and balanced, with abundant red fruits and hints of menthol. Good length on the palate, a significant aromatic presence and balanced tannins. A very charming wine.
