Wine description

The Côte de Beaune-Villages appellation is applied exclusively to red wines from 16 communes in the Côte de Beaune including Saint-Aubin, Pernand-Vergelesses and Auxey-Duresses. Maison Louis Latour carefully selects the wines which are the most representative of the appellation: lots of character, intense aromatics, and of course, a long finish.

Tasting note

The Côte de Beaune-Villages 2010 reveals a shiny red color with a beautiful deepness. The typical red fruit nose is dominated by cherry. Good suppleness on the palate, this wine is rather round with some spicy notes.
