The Côte de Beaune-Villages appellation is applied exclusively to red wines from 16 communes in the Côte de Beaune including Saint-Aubin, Pernand-Vergelesses and Auxey-Duresses. Maison Louis Latour carefully selects the wines which are the most representative of the appellation: lots of character, intense aromatics, and of course, a long finish.

Tasting note

This wine has a lovely garnet colour. On the nose, our Côte-de-Beaune Villages 2011 reveals aromas of blackcurrant and raspberry. In the mouth it is delicious and

very fresh, with notes of spices and red and black berries.
