Wine description

The village of Marsannay lies to the south of Dijon and marks the northern gateway to the Côte d'Or. Marsannay received its Appellation Contrôlée as recently as 1987 in recognition of the consistently high quality of its wine. The wines are characterised by their robust and intense structure, influenced by the iron-based soils on which they grow.

Tasting note

Ruby red in colour with raspberry and earthy aromas on the nose. In the mouth this Marsannay is medium bodied and fleshy; mellow tannins and good acidity provide a pleasing backbone. The wine has flavours of ripe blackberries, red plums and minerality which all end with a rounded, lingering finish.
