Wine description

Located close to the coast with views of the Indian Ocean, the name Burnside has its origins in Ireland where it means one who lives by a burn or stream. The fruit is from the Hazel's vineyard which is McHenry Hohnen's southernmost vineyard.

Tasting note

Aromas of grapefruit, peach and roasted nuts balanced with barrel ferment and matchstick notes. Extended time on lees brings a savoury character to the palate which is both powerful and defined by a core of natural acidity.
