Wine description

Located close to the coast with views of the Indian Ocean, the name Burnside has its origins in Ireland where it means one who lives by a burn or stream. The fruit is from the Hazel's vineyard which is McHenry Hohnen's southernmost vineyard.

Tasting note

Aromas of pink grapefruit, grilled peach and freshly baked pastry give way to flinty notes. The palate combines power and grace with a delicious savoury character framed by a core of creamy acidity. Generous in both flavour and acidity, the uniqueness of this wine captures Burnside's personality.
