# Hazel's Vineyard Chardonnay McHenry Hohnen

### Wine description

The Hazel's Vineyard lies in the headwaters of the Chapman Brook, near Witchcliffe. With a northerly aspect, the vines enjoy long days of sunshine, moderated by the vineyard's southern location. Viticultural practices at McHenry Hohnen's embrace old-school holistic farming philosophies and biodynamic practices which cultivate an environment where the soil and its organisms co-exist in a thriving equilibrium.

# **Tasting note**

On the nose a lifted bouquet of mandarin peal and lemon curd with struck match aromas adding layers of complexity. Creamy and textured this Chardonnay's purity of flavour is well balanced with succulent acidity.
