Wine description

The Hazel's Vineyard lies in the headwaters of the Chapman Brook, near Witchcliffe. With a northerly aspect, the vines enjoy long days of sunshine, moderated by the vineyard's southern location. Viticultural practices at McHenry Hohnen's embrace old-school holistic farming philosophies and biodynamic practices which cultivate an environment where the soil and its organisms co-exist in a thriving equilibrium.

Tasting note

Intensely fruity and floral aromas such as mandarin peel, white blossom and ruby grapefruit. Creamy, nutty and textured, this Chardonnay is powerful with a beautiful fruit concentration. It is elegant and a true representation of this south Margaret River vineyard just inland from the coast
