Wine description

The McHenry Hohnen vines at the Hazel's vineyard are surrounded by a complex ecosystem, where native bushland, cover crops, fruit orchards, beehives and grazing animals contribute to create a thriving environment rich in biodiversity. The climate here is slightly more "continental" due to the vines seating 10km further inland than the Calgardup vines. The wines which are handmade in tiny quantities are sourced from the best blocks.

Tasting note

A beautiful nose revealing mandarin peal, white blossom and mealy aromas as well as white nectarine and a seductive nougat element. Flinty and complex, this Chardonnay is powerful in fruit concentration and restrained by a precise acid line.
