Wine description

This wine is a blend of the three vineyards owned by McHenry Hohnen; Calgardup Brook, Hazel's, Burnside and Chapman Brook. All three vineyards have Lateritic soils, some of the oldest soils on the planet. They encourage the vine roots to explore deep to find water and nutrients and be self-sufficient.

Tasting note

This wine is a true expression of Southern Margaret River Chardonnay. On the nose delicate notes of kaffir lime, jasmine, and zesty ginger complemented by complex barrel ferment elements of cashews and flint rock. The palate is powerful with savoury aromas.
