Wine description

The grapes are from the clay and ironstone pebbly soils prevalent on the McHenry Hohnen Vineyards south of Margaret River. With a northerly aspect, the vines enjoy long days of sunshine, moderated by the vineyard's southern location. Vineyard management embraces sustainable 'old school' practices following biodynamic principles.

Tasting note

An earthy and intense blend, made via traditional method vinification, reveals a complex and alluring wine that is an authentic representation of variety, site and season. Made with minimal additives, this bold natural wine is unfinned and unfiltered. Each variety contributes to a complete yet enigmatic blend, far exceeding the sum of the individual parts.
