### Wine description

The grapes are from the clay and ironstone pebbly soils prevalent on the McHenry Hohnen Vineyards south of Margaret River. With a northerly aspect, the vines enjoy long days of sunshine, moderated by the vineyard's southern location. Made with minimal additives, this bold natural wine is unfinned and unfiltered. Each variety contributes to a complete wine, far exceeding the sum of the individual parts.

### Tasting note

An intense and fragrant mix of cranberry and black olives, with underlying after dinner mint and sweet spices. This wine offers a complex palate brimming with blackcurrant and crushed violet fruits, overlaying a dense mocha and sweet soy mid palate.
