Wine description

Margaret River is a known lair for Tiger snakes and in the local vernacular 'Tiger Country' means a tough and hard terrain. The soils that make the region's best wines are composed of clay and ironstone pebbles, great for the vine and accommodating for the 'Tigers'.

Tasting note

The wines displays aromas of cherry cola and ripe black plum with underlying sweet spice and savoury peanut husk notes to complete the complex bouquet. A supple palate brimming with ripe plum and sweet cola nut fruit gives way to red strap liquorice and dusty cocoa tannins.
