Wine description

Back in 2017, Steve Smith and Brian Sheth were honoured to take on the legacy of Pyramid Valley and craft their own family of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay wines. In 2018, they purchased a new vineyard, the Manata Estate in Central Otago. With some of the oldest vines in the region and high in natural humus and organic matter, exceptional Pinot Noir are being produced here.

Tasting note

Fragrant blackberry and raspberry with hints of liquorice, black pepper and clove. Sweet red plum, cherry and spice. Richly textured with lovely minerality. Complex with a long and silky sweet berry finish.
