Wine description

McHenry Hohnen's 2011 Semillon Sauvignon Blanc is a 60/40 blend and, for the first time, is made entirely from the family's own vineyards. Semillon came from the in-laws on the east side of Margaret River town, sauvignon blanc from the Burnside vineyard and a little bit of both varieties from the Calgardup Brook vineyard. This gave an eclectic mixture of fruit that shows firmly in the bottle. In another first, 5% of each variety was put into French oak barrels for a natural yeast fermentation.
